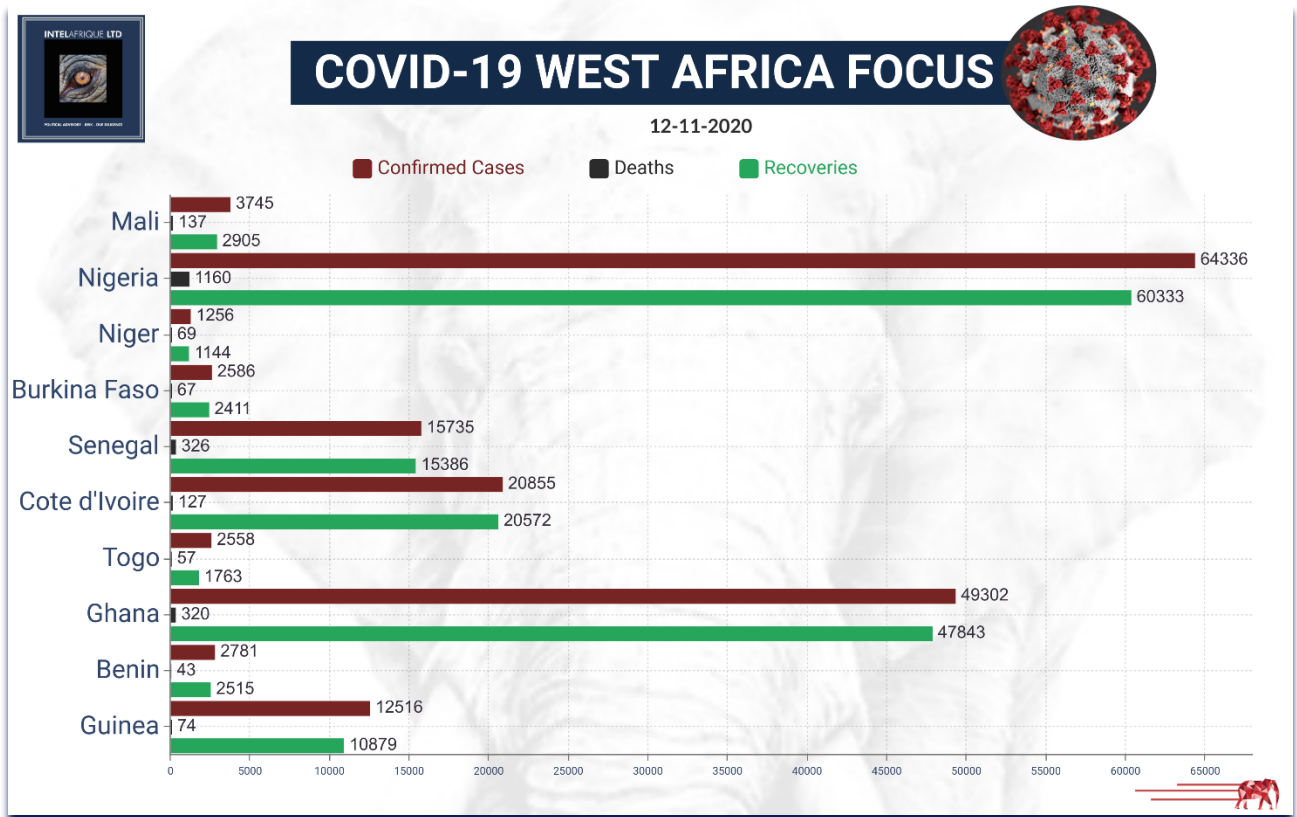

## COVID-19 UPDATE

### TOGO

Confirmed Cases: 2,558

Death: 57

Recovered: 1,763



### CURRENT SITUATION



Confirmed cases are at 2,558. Death toll is at 57. 129,834 tests have been completed with a positivity rate of 2%. Several restrictions have been eased to re-open the economy. Government has launched decentralised teams to enforce control measures for tracking asymptomatic cases in districts. Most of the infected cases have been traced to Golfe and Agoè prefectures in the capital, Lome.

### IVORY COAST

Confirmed Cases: 20,855

Death: 127

Recovered: 20,572



### CURRENT SITUATION



20,855 C-19 cases have been recorded in Ivory Coast. Current death toll is 127 while recoveries have reached 20,572. Active cases are now at 156. While fatality rates are significantly low at 0.6%, public health cautionary measures are advised especially in the capital, Abidjan where cases have been prevalent. Election spike has not been witnessed yet.

## SENEGAL

**Confirmed Cases:** 15,735  
**Death:** 326  
**Recovered:** 15,386



### CURRENT SITUATION

Senegal has recorded 15,735 cases in total with 15 new cases. Fatalities remain at 326 and recoveries at 15,386 with one in critical condition. The active cases number at 23. Response protocol has however remained the same. Airports require advanced testing of a negative COVID-19 obtained 5 days prior to arrival in-country. The land border with the Gambia is open and requires a negative COVID-19 test to cross all land borders.

## BURKINA FASO

**Confirmed Cases:** 2,586  
**Death:** 67  
**Recovered:** 2,411



### CURRENT SITUATION



Confirmed cases are currently at 2,586. The number of deaths has remained at 67 (2.6%) while recoveries have increased to 2,411 (93.2%). The government continues to emphasize adhering to public health safety protocols as public compliance wanes. Active case number 105. In the past week, cases have emerged in Ouagadougou, Bobo-Dioulasso and Banfora.

## BENIN

Confirmed Cases: **2,781**

Death: **43**

Recovered: **2,515**



## CURRENT SITUATION



Confirmed C-19 cases have increased to 2,781. Number of deaths remained at 43 while recoveries recorded at 2,515. 269,280 tests have been conducted with a 1% positivity rate. Government management directs health compliance among public, work and private institutions as testing and tracing teams continue their work.
