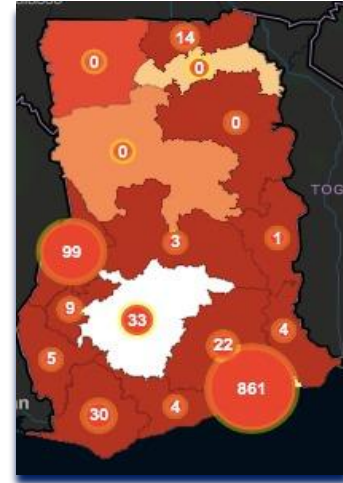




## CODVID-19 UPDATE GHANA

Death: 320

### CURRENT SITUATION

The Ghana Health Service has reported **100** new cases of COVID-19, taking the cumulative tally **49,302**. Death toll from the dreaded disease remains **320** and a total of **47,843** persons have recovered. Greater Accra remains the heaviest hit region in the country with 861 active cases. Bono Region is just one case shy of entering the hundred mark.

### COMMENTARY

The cases continue to climb in urban centres which see the most commercial and political electioneering activity. The Ghana Health Service says as far as adherence to the preventive protocols is a concern and general apathy continues. It is unlikely that we would see a reduction in cases soon with this new trajectory. The nation should prepare for the second wave both forecasted by the Ghana Medical Association Ghana Health Service and WHO. Lockdown of urban centres is not an option for President, Nana Akufo-Addo and unrealistic at this stage. Personal responsibility is cited as key.

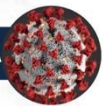
### CONCLUSION

Despite the low death rate, active cases have doubled in 10 days. Working from home is still seen for many corporate and larger business interests. Lack of social distancing and mask-wearing are a concern and reflects fatigue and lack of government education and political priorities prioritised. Effective ceasing of tracing and controls outside ports of entry are disguising any accurate detail and infection rates can be considered x 5 but until fatalities are attributed to Covid and the figure remains static, little action is envisaged until after the new election cycle.
