DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

- Completed crew list for On-signers and/or Off-signers
- Copies of passports
- Copies of seamens' books
- Copies of Negative Covid-19 tests for unvaccinated or partially vaccinated On-signers (dated max 05 days before boarding)
 OR proof of vaccination for fully vaccinated On-Signers.
- Copies of flight details
- On-signers must complete the Declaration of Air Travel via this link: https://deplacement-aerien.gouv.ci/#/home and pay the fee of 2.000 f CFA

PROCEDURES

- Vessels will be inspected by Port Health at anchorage, once completed satisfactorily crew changes can commence.
- On-signers will be transferred directly to the vessel or to the hotel under quarantine conditions.
- Off-signers will be transferred directly to the airport or to the hotel where they will remain under quarantine conditions.

PLEASE NOTE

Arrivals:

- Un-vaccinated or partially vaccinated passengers must have a printed negative COVID-19 PCR test taken at most 72 hours (day of test + 2 days) before arrival.
- Fully vaccinated passengers (two doses) must have proof of vaccination.
- A completed "Health Declaration Form" must be submitted before departure at https://deplacement-aerien.gouv.ci.
 The form must be printed and presented upon arrival.

Departures:

- Passengers with proof of complete vaccination are exempt from PCR testing when travelling to a country that does not require it as an entry health document
- Passengers partially vaccinated or unvaccinated will require proof of a negative PCR an entry health document
- ▶ The validity of the PCR test results has changed from 48h to 72h with effect from 07/03/22
